1. Will submissions be reviewed on a first-come, first-served basis?

No, all submissions will receive equal opportunity for consideration after the submission period closes and will *not* be reviewed on a first-come, first-served basis. The submission period will close on February 16, 2022.

2. Do I need to answer all questions on the submission form?

Yes. Please answer all questions on the submission form. You may mark those questions that are not applicable to your submission as "N/A", but all questions must be answered.

4. What is the expected funding range for proposed projects?

While there is no "expected" funding range for proposed projects, note that Kansas has \$746M remaining in State Fiscal Recovery Funds as of January 2022. SPARK expects to allocate the remaining funds to investment proposals across the 4 Advisory Panels.

5. Can I select multiple Advisory Panels for my proposed project?

No. Please pick the one Advisory Panel that best aligns with your investment idea's purpose.
